IN-WATER DISPLAY GUIDELINES

FREIGHT RULES

- There is a maximum freight allowance of 1,000 pounds for every 10'x 40' float*
- There is a maximum freight allowance of 500 pounds for every 10'x20' float*
- Tents with glass walls will be calculated into your display weight and will further restrict your display weight limits
- Exhibitors must provide NMMA a layout of the in-water display for approval, and a freight manifest prior to receiving and unloading crates

CRATE WEIGHT LIMITS AND DELIVERY PROCESS

- There is a maximum 750 pound crate weight limit. (Includes contents and crate combined).
- ◆ If any crate and content exceeds 750lbs, it must be broken down to the 750lb weight limit. A breakdown and handling fee of \$95.00 per every 100lbs pounds over will be applied.
- Crates will be delivered three units at a time. Once emptied they will need to be tagged and picked up before any remaining crates are delivered.
- All crates will need to be tagged with empty stickers and off the docks by Tuesday, February 12th 2pm.
- Freight returned unused and for storage during the show, will be assessed a handling fee.

*Examples: A 40'x40' reception area can accommodate a maximum of 4,000 lbs. of freight. A 20'x20' reception area can accommodate a maximum of 1,000 lbs. of freight. (Standard Tent without Glass Walls)
