BEFORE SHIPPING:

Complete payment with Informa Markets US Boat Shows by check or on the payment portal, link below.

WHEN TO SHIP:

Warehouse advance rate deadline is January 17th. Shipments received thereafter, standard rate will apply.

However, shipments consigned to the warehouse after show site staging has opened, an additional 50% special handling fee will apply.

Staging opens February 1st.

Shipments consigned to show site must arrive 2 days prior to your set-up date.

All carriers are required to check in at staging first located at 1450 N Bayshore Drive, Miami, FL 33312.

COLLECT SHIPMENTS OR LOOSE OR UNCRATED MATERIALS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
