WHEN TO SHIP:

Advance rate deadline is January 18th. Shipments received thereafter, standard rate will apply.

However, shipments consigned to the warehouse after SHOW SITE STAGING has opened, an additional 50% special handling fee will apply. Shipments consigned to SHOW SITE must arrive 2 days prior to your set-up date.

On Show Site shipments, all carriers are required to check in at staging. Staging location to be determined.

COLLECT SHIPMENTS OR LOOSE OR UNCRATED MATERIALS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
